Dear Parent,

We're planning our bi-annual trip to Soul Survivor, and we'd love for your child to be able to come with us to this amazing Christian festival in Somerset. Although I had previously told some of you that we would be attending week B as we have in previous years, I must apologise and let you know that that has now changed to week C (16-21 August). That's because of an exciting development, meaning we'll be joining with at least two other local churches for the trip (Bromham Baptist Church and Priory Methodist Church).

Because of this late development, I don't yet know the exact price for the trip as we are looking at sharing transport and catering, but the price is likely to be around £130. This will include transport, catering and entry to the event. The accommodation is camping, so nearer to the time as we sort out tent allocations we may be asking if you have a tent that we could borrow.

If your child hasn't been to a Soul Survivor event in the past, you may be wondering a bit more about the festivals and what's entailed. It consists of a programme of morning and evening worship, seminar streams during the day, themed cafes and sports/skate venues, evening gigs and the ultimate disco in 'Mr Boogies'. Of course it's hard to describe a festival with 10,000 young people in a few words, and there's far more to be seen done and experienced than you see here. Most of all, many find it a time away from day to day life in which they can seek God and experience him in a new way.

I really hope that your child is able to come on this exciting trip. Whilst we don't know the exact price yet, we would ask that you pay a deposit of £30 and fill in the form attached so that we can start booking tickets. If you are concerned that the price may cause your child not to be able to come, please do get in touch, as we'd hate for that to exclude anyone from attending. We'll do our best to work something out.
